



NeighborWoods

What is it? A program for neighborhood groups to receive one free tree per homeowner who desires one for their front yard.

Who plants? Volunteers from the neighborhood & community; Up With Trees staff; and the homeowners themselves. If a homeowner is unable to plant, they are encouraged to assist in other ways, e.g., bringing food to the planting day kick-off.

Where? Tulsa County only at this time.

When? NeighborWoods plantings occur in October through April on Saturday mornings, as scheduled by Up With Trees.

Which trees? Homeowners select their preference from a list of available trees, including shade, ornamental and evergreen trees.

How do I participate? Obtain an application online or by calling the Up With Trees office. A representative from the neighborhood group must fill out one application for the entire area, then coordinate delivery and collection of approval forms from individual homeowners.
